THE LATE PAUL GRUNDEMANN HONORED BY DRCOG

April 28, 2010 (Denver, Colorado) –The late Paul Grundemann, former director of operations of the Centennial Water & Sanitation District, received a Distinguished Service Award from the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG). The award was presented to his wife Theresa Grundemann by Arapahoe County Commissioner and DRCOG Chair Rod Bockenfeld at the regional council's 2010 Awards of Excellence Dinner, held April 28 at the Infinity Park Event Center in Glendale.

The award recognizes Mr. Grundemann's commitment and leadership to the region and state on water quality issues throughout his long and distinguished career. This is Mr. Grundemann's second Distinguished Service Award from DRCOG. He first received the honor in 1994.
