DAN GRUNIG HONORED BY DRCOG

April 28, 2010 (Denver, Colorado) –Dan Grunig, executive director of Bicycle Colorado, has received a Distinguished Service Award from the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG). The award was presented by Arapahoe County Commissioner and DRCOG Chair Rod Bockenfeld at the regional council’s 2010 Awards of Excellence Dinner, held April 28 at the Infinity Park Event Center in Glendale.

The award recognizes Grunig’s commitment to regional bicycle and pedestrian planning efforts.
