NOLAN KNOX HONORED BY DRCOG

April 28, 2010 (Denver, Colorado) –Nolan Knox, former director of nutrition services for the Volunteers of America, received a Distinguished Service Award from the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG). The award was presented by Littleton Council Member and DRCOG Vice Chair Jim Taylor at the regional council's 2010 Awards of Excellence Dinner, held April 28 at the Infinity Park Event Center in Glendale.

The award recognizes Knox's more than 20 years of dedicated service to the Denver region's older adults through his work at VOA supervising the largest senior nutrition program in the state.
