Non-Routine Inspection Services Available from DRCOG

Acceptance Inspections; Re-inspections; and Special Inspections for construction/temporary use, review of modifications, and witnessing of safety tests)

1. All non-routine inspections require a one-time processing fee of \$25 per site. Commercial acceptance inspections are \$500 per unit and include plan review. Residential or small conveyance* acceptance inspections are charged at \$350 per unit and include plan review. Payments are due in advance of the acceptance inspection.

To request an acceptance inspection, download and print the *Request for Acceptance Inspection* form, fill it out and either fax or mail it in along with this signed form and payment, per instructions provided and schedule directly with the appropriate inspector.

2. A \$450 per unit fee is charged for re-inspections. Payment must be made in advance (per visit -- if each visit requires a comprehensive inspection).

To request a re-inspection, download and print the *Request for Re-inspection* form, fill it out and either fax or mail it in with payment per instructions provided and schedule directly with the appropriate inspector.

3. Special Inspections (for review of modifications, construction/temporary use or witnessing safety inspections) are billed at \$75 per hour with a 2-hour minimum to be paid in advance of the inspection. Witnessing of safety tests requires prepayment of \$150 per unit. No shows after ½ hour are subject to \$150 minimum fee with or without re-schedule.

To request a special inspection for such things as construction use, minor review of modifications, or witnessing of safety tests, download and print the *Request for Special Inspection* form, fill it out and either email, fax, or mail it in with payment per instructions provided and schedule directly with the appropriate inspector.

*Include: wheel chair lifts, stair chairs and material lifts.
