

Remote testing out-of-state

If a group (**two or more—no individual testers please**) of individuals would like to take the test at a location outside of Colorado for placement into the DRCOG eligibility pool for November, our staff can make that happen. You will need to identify a proctor in your area, preferably someone at a community college that agrees to administer the test to the group. The proctor's contact information must be sent to Suzi Walker swalker@drcog.org for approval. Once the proctor is approved, the candidates may apply for the firefighter exam online. The test vendor will then work directly with the proctor with test administration details. **Note: For those taking the test at a remote location outside of Colorado; there is an additional \$50 administration fee over and above the normal registration fee of \$50 to take the test. The total fee to test is \$100, which is by far cheaper than airfare to Denver.**

If you want to take the test out of state, you must have arrangements finalized by Sept. 15—no exceptions.
