**11:15 Meeting Summary Approval – Meeting #62, March 17, 2025 – Stand as written**

**11:20 CDOT/RTD/DRCOG 4 P Meetings** are to gain a common understanding of the transportation needs of the cities, the county, DRCOG, CDOT, & RTD and how the needs fit into the planned revenues over 2027-2030. And to discuss updating CDOTS 10-year plan for 2027-2036, and Transportation Commission Goals.

**West End of County (University – West Boundary)**

Previous List included: US 85 corridor, C470 to I-25, US 285, PEL Study, Broadway BRT & Study Improvements

**Littleton** – Bowles & Santa Fe improvements, Santa Fe corridor study, Belleview corridor to add multi modal esp south side, Mineral & Broadway, Littleton Blvd & Broadway intersection improvements, Broadway & Mineral improvements, Broadway Fiber current and future project, and safety projects, RTD asset collaboration.

Developments: Costco at Mineral & Santa Fe construction has begun, hospital expansion at Mineral and Broadway, Evergreen Toll Brothers and Santa Fe and Mineral: redevelopment of commercial to residential, residential development at

Federal and Belleview, Littleton Village at Broadway just north of Dry Creek residential and a little commercial.

**Englewood** – Projects identified in the 285 Traffic Study: S Broadway Complete Streets project, DRCOG grant to evaluate BRT in that corridor, Belleview & Broadway multi-modal on the north side, Rail trail project starts at Dartmouth and goes south parallel to tracks towards Oxford design currently, in 2025 to complete Englewood's Transportation Plan

Development: Sam's Auto at Oxford and Santa Fe & Improvements to Oxford and Windemere.

**Centennial:** Broadway and Arapahoe with Highline Canal Underpass, Development: Streets at Southglenn @ University not sure when it will take off more multi family in area and less commercial

**Cherry Hills:** no projects for this list

**Greenwood Village:** Belleview & I-25 Interchange

**Arapahoe County:** looking to partner with Centennial & Littleton

#### **Central County (University – West Side of E-470)**

Previous list included: I-25/Belleview interchange, I-225 improvements, Alameda bridge replacement and enhancements over I-25, Parker Rd corridor improvements, Parker/Quincy improvements & Arapahoe Rd corridor suggested improvements.

**Aurora:** Multi-modal master plan networks identified for bike, transit projects that honor complete neighborhoods vision, transit side Bustang in the I-70 corridor, Colfax BRT from I-225 out to I-70/Picadilly Gun Club area, Parker/Quincy/Smoky Hill intersection improvements, Alameda bridge improvements construction needs funding

Development: Horizon City Center east of Stratford Business Park, btwn Picadilly & I-70 & E470/Gun Club, hospital development south of I-70 and east side of E470, Harvest Ridge south of Jewell & west of Harvest Rd

**Centennial:** Project at Arapahoe and Jordan, Arapahoe Rd operation improvements,

Development: district north of IKEA & Vermillion Creek east of Tagawa & west of Parker, Colorado Blvd. implementing DRT most of which is in Denver

**Arapahoe County:** I-25/Belleview, I-225, County Line & Inverness Dr West construction, Yale @ Holly to Kearney, Parker Rd study wrapping up with recommended corridor improvements: Mississippi to Hampden sidepath proposal, Pedestrian improvements along & further study of Parker rd and Florida, Peoria & Easter intersection improvement

Development: Arcadia on Florida- the Potters church redevelopment, Dove Valley, Yale and Dry Creek stations locations for rezoning for high density

#### **East End of County (E-470 – East Boundary)**

Previous projects list: Gun Club/Quincy north on CDOT 10 year plan, intersection safety improvements at Hampden and Picadilly, I-70, SH 79 multi use path with

full interchange at Kiowa/Bennett with bridge replacement and ramps, I-70 Airpark & Watkins and I-70, I-70/Quail Run, SH 79 improvements, I-70 corridor transit/bustang/TDM Capacity assessments.

**Aurora:** I-70 Bustang on east corridor integrated with mobility hubs, TDM arrow shuttle serving Aurora Highlands, closing in on TDM connections, I-70/Quail Run, Developments: Port Colorado, build-out on Harvest Rd corridor south of I-70

**Bennett:** Multi modal pathway project (tip funded), bridge replacement on 79 & I-70 interchange, bridge at Kiowa/Bennett in master plan will need attention soon, new project is the Planning Study: south of I-70 between Harback and the creek and from I-70 south to Alameda to plan for development.

**Arapahoe County:** Monahan, I-70 TDM, Gun Club improvements from Aurora Pkwy to I-70 part is SH 30,  
Development: Prosper, Sky Ranch, Watkins Rd/I-70

**John Gardocki with CDOT:** DTR Transit connection study draft in May and can speak more on Bustang services. And do you still want us to present 4P info at Executive Comm Mtg on May 15? (Will need to schedule another TC meeting, perhaps May 5<sup>th</sup>)

CDOT 10-Year Plan Development Timeline (Arapahoe County)-hope to adopt in December 2025  
Mid July draft of plans for time period of 2027-2036. On the list:

I-25/Belleview interchange - \$110M, \$22M

SH 30 Improvement (Quincy- Airport) - \$25M,

CDOT (Telecia), Aurora (Mac), and Arapahoe County will need to discuss SH30

RTD Plans – For the 4P meeting: update finishing Fast Tracks report, interested in update on bus stop study?, speed limitation on rail, System Optimization Plan to establish framework for improvements for the future, Funding availability

**DRCOG called together all the Subregional Forums for the Coordination Meeting 4-2-25**

2050 Regional Transportation Plan update on timeline now thru 2026 now in 'Scenario Planning Stage' to present in May, and to Adopt in August/September of 2026

FY 2028 TIP Programming to align with Federal funding to look at during 2<sup>nd</sup> half of 2025, look at wait list projects, fund next phases of existing projects, & new call for projects

FY 2029-2032 TIP Development for adoption in 2028

Upcoming call for projects: Corridor Planning Program set aside call for projects

DRCOG: meeting to plan RTP and candidate projects, 4P and Transportation Plan overlap, but 2050 RTP planning out long term, 4p is current, TIP actually implements the 2050 RTP,

Mac asked: 2028 RTP call for project plan, what type of projects will be on it? More transportation/land use planning. Todd: 2028 TIP may have a new call for projects depending on funding so 2028 definitions haven't been clearly defined but will not be a full call of projects for fy2028 only and will be forum specific. More to be discussed at TAC next week & with Board
