Project Name: Missing Sidewalks and Curb Ramps along Federal Blvd

Project Type: Design

Project Description:

This project builds from the momentum of the Federal Boulevard Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Project and ensures that all transit riders and pedestrians can safely walk and roll to their final destinations along the corridor. While the Federal Blvd BRT Project is constructing many missing sidewalks along the corridor, the BRT project cannot fund all missing sidewalks.

The purpose of this project is to complete all design, preliminary engineering and construction documents for missing sidewalks and curb ramps along Federal Boulevard in unincorporated Adams County, that are outside of the scope of the Federal Blvd BRT project. Many of these sidewalks are near Clear Creek Transit Station and near commercial areas that are hubs of pedestrian activity. The Federal Blvd BRT Project has completed 20% design for missing sidewalks and curb ramps. Adams County's Missed Connections project will pick-up where the BRT is leaving off, carry out design, preliminary engineering and final construction documents.

Total Project Cost: \$625,000
