Summary

The Regional Transportation Committee (RTC) is the Denver Regional Council of Governments' Metropolitan Planning Organization committee that assists the Board of Directors by reviewing the work of the metropolitan transportation planning process and preparing regional transportation planning policy recommendations. The [metropolitan planning agreement](#) between the Denver Regional Council of Governments, Colorado Department of Transportation, and Regional Transportation District requires that the Board of Directors and Regional Transportation Committee concur on all decisions.
