Resolution No. 39, 2025

A resolution authorizing the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Fehr and Peers to provide near miss data collection and countermeasure development for DRCOG and the City of Thornton's Near Miss Analysis project in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for a period of 12 months from the date of contract execution.

Whereas, DRCOG established the Innovative Mobility set-aside program to assist regional partners as they plan for, and prepare, innovative solutions to mobility challenges in the Denver region; and

Whereas, a total of four million dollars is available in the Innovative Mobility set-aside over the four-year period of the 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program; and

Whereas, the Thornton Near Miss Analytics project was approved by the DRCOG board in December 2024 and seeks to collect near miss events at 10 intersections in the City of Thornton along DRCOG's High-Injury Network to be used alongside historic crash data to develop actionable countermeasures to lead to improved traffic safety outcomes.

Whereas, DRCOG conducted a competitive bidding process administered by a selection panel consisting of staff from DRCOG's Regional Transportation Planning team, Active and Emerging Mobility team, and contracting team as well as City of Thornton traffic engineers.

Whereas, the selection panel determined that Fehr and Peers submitted the best overall proposal that demonstrated their experience, capability and understanding to successfully deliver the required services.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Finance and Budget Committee authorizes the Executive Director to negotiate and execute a contract with Fehr and Peers to provide near miss data collection and countermeasure development for DRCOG and the City of Thornton's Near Miss Analytics project in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 for a period of 12 months from the date of contract execution.
