2026-2027 Transportation Demand Management Set-Aside Funding Recommendations

Summary

Project funding recommendations for the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) set-aside.

Background

The [Policies for FY 2024-2027 TIP Set-aside Programs](#) established \$2 million in federal funds for TDM non-infrastructure projects over the four-year period. The 2026-27 call for projects was for \$1,000,000 plus \$95,000 returned from the previous cycle, for a total of \$1,095,000. The purpose of the TDM set-aside is to support marketing, outreach and research projects that reduce traffic congestion and improve air quality.

In May 2025, after conducting a workshop for potential applicants, DRCOG issued a call for Letters of Intent followed by a call for applications. Applications and Letters of Concurrence were due July 3, 2025. A Project Review Panel made up of DRCOG staff and external partners such as CDOT, RAQC and Ride NoCo reviewed and rated each of the seven applications received. After discussion, the Panel recommended funding all seven projects.
